

Requirements for the Sacrament of Confirmation
2015-2016

- Students must turn in a signed copy of the Candidate's Promise during class.
- Students must attend all Confirmation Classes in preparation for the Sacrament. Should a candidate miss class, it is his/her responsibility to contact Sylvia and John Dillon to let them know prior to missing class. The student will then have to make up work from that week. Try to reschedule any conflicts by taking a look at the calendar now.
- Confirmation students will be presented to the parish community at the **10:30 A.M. Mass on Sunday, October 18th in the Rite of Introduction**. Students will sit with their families and come forward as their names are called. Sponsors are welcome to attend the Rite of Introduction Mass as well.
- Students must choose a Sponsor and turn in the required form by **November 1st**.
- Students will volunteer for 10 hours as they prepare for Confirmation, understanding that service is an important element of the Catholic faith.
- Students will participate in a one-on-one meeting with the Pastor, Fr. Joe, or with their catechists to discuss readiness for the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- Students will attend Masses on Sunday, participate in a Confirmation retreat, and celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation, either on their own or at a Communal Penance Service as celebrated during Advent or Lent.
- Each student will need to supply a copy of his/her Baptismal Certificate if not on file here at Our Lady of the Lake. A certificate can be obtained by calling the parish where the student was baptized and requesting a copy. This is due no later than **January 17th**, when the PDS form is due as well.
